Harvey Disaster Response

Dear Friends in Christ,

As you are aware, the damage from Hurricane Harvey is widespread and ongoing. Our response as a church to this disaster is three-fold:

- 1. Pray for the people in the communities impacted by the storm.
- 2. Give to disaster recovery. Already you have given just under \$4000 so thank you! You can give to disaster recovery beginning this Sunday in all of our worship services. If you give in worship, mark you payments for Disaster Relief. If you give online, select the "Benevolence" option. All monies donated in the "Benevolence" option will be directed to disaster relief. We are also receiving supplies for Health Kits and supplies for children.
- 3. We have made a connection with First United Methodist Church of Vidor, TX. Pastor John Mooney reports that 80% of the homes in Vidor were flooded including their church and parsonage. Please pray for him, his wife Sharon, and their two young children, Tony and Austin, and their community. We are planning on taking a mission team to Vidor on Wednesday, September 27 31st. The team will depart from the church at 4 pm on the 27th and arrive home the evening of the 31st
- . At this time we plan to focus on debris removal from homes and home cleanout. If you are interested in being part of a work team, please call the church office at 228-863-9619.


Sharing the Light of Christ

Preparations. We are preparing for assisting the recovery effort in Texas after Harvey, but we are also making preparations for the possibility that the Mississippi Gulf Coast might bear the brunt of a hurricane before the end of the season. The preparation involves partnering with local and out of area churches to aid in the immediate aftermath of a storm.

First, we are working with Christ UMC of Long Beach for the emergency use of some of their space for worship and offices, if the main campus is damaged too badly. They were gracious enough to allow us to worship there following Katrina until the sanctuary could be made ready for use once again. We thank them again for their graciousness.

Secondly, we are partnered with Heritage UMC outside of Hattiesburg. They have offered to our church family space in their homes for whoever needs to evacuate from Long Beach before or right after a storm. Should you need to evacuate, please call the church office and we will help you. In addition, they would be poised to offer their staff to help and work teams to aid in recovery in the short and long term. Many thanks to Heritage for their gracious partnership.

Thirdly, if Harrison County is included in a Tropical Storm Watch or Warning or a Hurricane Watch, all programs are subject to cancellation and will be handled on a case by case basis. If a Hurricane Warning is issued, all programs are automatically cancelled. In the event of a storm, we will continue to update information by emails and social media. Please make sure that we have a current email address so we can keep you informed in the event of a storm.

We pray we will never need this plan, but are thankful for those willing to partner with us and pray for all those who are in the path of storms and recovering.
