## We have several ways you can get in the spirit of Christmas during our Advent season!

**Sunday, November 18th-** We will prepare the sanctuary for Advent by hanging the greenery after services at 12:00 p.m. We need some volunteers to get our buildings ready for Christmas!

**Saturday, December 1st-** We will host a snow station for kids at the Town green after the Long Beach community boat parade. We are looking for a few volunteers to run the snow station and hand out goody bags with our calendar of events in them. (6:30 p.m.-7:30 p.m.)

**Sunday, December 2nd-** We will decorate the Chrismon tree in the sanctuary at 10:00 a.m. Everyone is invited to come sing Christmas carols and participate in the decorating of the tree.

**Sunday, December 2nd-** We will spend the afternoon wrapping Angel Tree gifts from 4:00-6:00 p.m. You can come for the whole time or join in the fun when you can! Bring a roll of wrapping paper, gift boxes, tissue paper, gift bags, or a roll of tape. You can bring these with you or donate them ahead of time. We will start collecting wrapping supplies as early as *Sunday, November 18th*. At 6:00 p.m., we will have a Chili Cook-off Dinner. Bring your favorite chili to enter into our competition! If chili is not your specialty, bring a side dish or a dessert to share. We will use money to vote for the best chili. The winner of the Chili Cook-off gets to decide which ministry or mission to give the money to!

**Monday, December 24th-** We will host our Annual Christmas Eve Lunch from 11:00 a.m-1:00 p.m. in the Christian Life Center. Volunteer sign-up sheets will be in the lobby of the sanctuary and The Well starting this *Sunday, November 18th.* We will also be collecting blankets, socks, and hygiene items to give away during the lunch.

#### **Angel Tree and Giving Tree:**

We have two ways to provide for the Christmas needs of our community children this year. We will have our annual **Angel Tree**. Tags will be available starting Sunday, November 18th. We are asking that ALL gifts purchased be returned by the morning of *Sunday, December 2nd*. We will have a church-wide opportunity to wrap the gifts that evening.

We will also have a **Giving Tree** this year. This will hold tags with smaller needs for children and families in our school district. Please take a tag and return the item to the tree after it has been purchased. The Giving Tree will be out year round to continually meet needs in our community.

Crack! That's the sound I heard when I backed my van into our mailbox this past Tuesday morning. I was taking Ryan, our son to school that morning because it was raining. Normally he walks to school because we only live 5 minutes away. But that day I wanted to drive him. When I got back home, I looked at the mailbox and the van and saw that the rear tail light assembly was cracked its entire length. So I ordered a replacement from our usual online car part site. By

the way, having a "usual" car part site is a whole other story.

Needless to say, I felt sick about this mess-up on my part and I begin to replay how it happened in my mind. The first thing I remembered was that there was a car nearby that's not usually there so I adjusted my usual backup route slightly which was just enough to hit the mailbox. But the thing is, I had means at my disposal to avoid the accident in the first place but I didn't take advantage of them. I had a backup camera that I didn't check. I had mirrors I didn't use, and finally I didn't turn my head around to look with my own eyes. I just blindly drove into a car repair.

I think this happens to all of us more than we realize - not the backing up into a mailbox part, but the not using the means we have to avoid bad decisions.

Sometimes we just drive blindly into bad situations because we don't use what is

available to us.

If we think about our lives and our walk with Jesus, we have means available to us to make really good decisions. We have a community of people to lean on to help us think about life. We have the means of discipleship such as prayer, scripture, and holy conversation with each other on which to draw. We have the gifts of compassion, love and forgiveness, to help each other through the hard steps of life. The only thing is that we often drive blindly through life without taking advantage of what God gives us.

When I heard that "crack" on Tuesday morning I count it as a gift that God offered me an opportunity to recognize my need to pay attention to what God has given me to help me when life happens in unexpected ways. What could life be like for you and I if we fully depend on what God has given us? Perhaps we would have fewer "cracks" in our lives and that could be a place to experience some

gratitude.
